Survivors/Victims of Tragedy and Black on Black Crime, Inc. are working together to purchase the building where the Memorial Wall/Wall of Sorrows is located and the adjacent lot. These properties have been put in the land bank. If we are able to preserve the Memorial Wall/Wall of Sorrows Building, there are several choices:

1. If every person in Cuyahoga County donated at least \$5.00, we could purchase the Memorial Wall Building and the adjacent lot.
2. We need to raise money to buy the property and renovate the Memorial Wall Building to create a Children's Holocaust Museum and Safe Place for Kids.
3. We need to raise money to create a Memorial Park and build a huge wall for the Memorial Wall, pictures, murals, etc., a brick courtyard and benches.

All monies donated will be used for the sole purpose of obtaining the building and adjacent lot, renovating the building and landscaping the property, maintaining or moving the Wall, and helping families put pictures, poems or other momentos on the Building. If enough money is not raised to buy these parcels and renovate the building, the money could be used to purchase 2 vacant lots and create a park for the Memorial Wall. A complete accounting of monies received and expenditures will be available upon request.
